

## Healthy Personians History/Timeline

- 11/2000 First Healthy Personians Steering Committee meeting
- 2/2001 Healthy Personians Steering Committee “Kick-off” dinner/meeting at Farmer’s Supply (Healthy Carolinians initiative introduced, community assessment results reported, mini-grant process discussed)
- 3/2001 Awarded mini-grants to support the Wellness Pays program, to purchase pneumonia vaccines for Person Family Medical Center, and to support the Youth Advisory Council’s “Project Celebration” on prom night. (At this time the three partner groups included the Substance Abuse Subcommittee, the Local Fitness and Nutrition Council, and the Adult Immunization Subcommittee).
- 5/2001 Mission statement “Personians helping Personians to be healthy” adopted
- 7/2001 PC Physical Activity & Nutrition Coalition officially formed
- 8/2001 Kate B. Reynolds Charitable Trust proposal reviewed. Grant writer hired.
- 9/2001 Grant proposal submitted to Kate B. Reynolds Charitable Trust.
- 12/2001 Healthy Personians awarded \$97,584 over the next 3 years (2002-2005) from Kate B. Reynolds Charitable Trust. Funding supported a full-time coordinator, operating and program budgets. Health department served as fiscal and administrative agent.
- 2001-2002 Awarded Healthy Carolinians funding (\$10,000)
- 2/2002 Healthy Personians Partnership awarded \$5,627 in mini-grants to support the following initiatives of 4 partner groups:  
- \*ABLE (All Bodies Like Exercise) Program \$1,560  
- \*SYBERSHOP & GYHAHB \$700  
*\*Initiatives of the Local Fitness And Nutrition Council*  
- SAFE Kids Coalition \$1,000

- Healthy Personians Coordinator hired
- 3/2002 Coordinator began work; housed at health department and placed under supervision of Health Director
- 4/2002 Healthy Personians Certification process began  
PC Physical Activity & Nutrition Coalition renamed the PC FAN (Fitness And Nutrition) Club
- 5/2002 Partnership logo chosen; Bylaws adopted



7/2004 Coordinator moved under supervision of Health Education Supervisor and Health Department's Health Education section; Coordinator's position for Healthy Personians duties now at 50%; other 50% of position is coordinating the new Teen Pregnancy Prevention Initiative/Teen Outreach Program

10/2004 Healthy Personians Partnership awarded Recertification by Governor's Task Force for Healthy Carolinians

12/2004 2004 State of the County Health Report released

1/2005 Healthy Personians awarded \$10,000 from the Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention Coalition of North Carolina/Comprehensive Community of Change Project to support Adolescent Health Coalition Initiatives (funding for Jan.-Dec. 05)

Awarded United Way funding (\$5,000)

6/2005 Kate B. Reynolds Charitable Trust awards the partnership \$45,000 for 2005-2008

2005/2006 Awarded Healthy Carolinians funding (\$5,000)

Funding awarded through the Piedmont HIV Consortium (\$248 to support efforts of the HIV Task Force)

8/2005 Implemented weekly Community Service Radio Spot Campaign (among overall partnership and 3 partner groups)
